This inaugural edition of the **DIABLO** is but the first of many that will be published on a trimester basis.

The **DIABLO** is the voice of the 'Family and Friends of The 508th PIR Association', which is being founded this year. Within its pages your inquiries, written memoirs and memorials will be regularly featured. News of general interest and information about the men of the 508th and their exploits from 1942 through 1945 will also be covered.

Some Background

More than 100 people filled out forms at the 30th, and final, reunion of the 508th PIR Association expressing interest in forming a follow-on organization. This edition is being mailed to over 1,400 people.

That effort pressed on and a few veterans and friends attended our business meeting held in Orange Park, FL in October 2005 (for more details see article at right).

During that session I was appointed as interim Chairman with the mission to appoint other board members and get the organization rolling.

Various items of business were voted upon, including the proposed Constitution and By-laws and the organization's name.

Good Intentions Foiled

However, since then we learned the voting process was nullified, as we had not yet incorporated. So, we shall re-address those items at our first annual reunion, as incorporation shall then be accomplished.

That reunion will be held, again in joint session with the HQ 1st and C Companies mini-reunion in Augusta, GA. You can read more about the event on the following page in Troy Palmer's "Hello to the 508th.

As you may know, the 508th's HQ 1st and C Companies hosted a "Mini Reunion" in Orange Park, Florida in October 2005.

Dubbed as the "First Anniversary Reunion", it fell on the date that marked the retirement of the 508th PIR Association (WW-II) just one year earlier.

Orange Park is quite close to Camp Blanding and we shared personal automobiles to travel to Camp Blanding where ceremonies were held at the 508th Memorial, the memorial for Medal of Honor winner Leonard A. Funk, Jr. and at DZ Diablo (although the 508th never jumped at Blanding it has been honored with the naming of this drop-zone nonetheless).

Following these ceremonies ample time was given to enable everyone to visit the Camp Blanding Museum, which features many 508th exhibits.

Special Meeting Included

On the last day of the reunion, a business meeting was held regarding the formation of a new association. This new organization has a genesis stemming from comments of numerous veterans and family members who felt that they would like to see something happen to carry on the spirit of the 508th PIR (WW-II) and the annual reunions so many of you enjoyed in past years.

The purpose of this new association will be to ensure that the memory and legacy of the 508th PIR is perpetuated and that the camaraderie of the 508th members and their families shall endure.

It is our sincere hope that many of the 508th PIR's veterans and family members will choose to sign up for membership and we encourage all recipients of the newsletter to pass this information on within their extended family.

How To Join

We have included a registration form for your convenience within this newsletter. An initiation fee of \$30 per person was set for the first year of operation. Annual dues have yet to be determined and will be decided at the next annual meeting. These funds will be used to support the association newsletter and will also go towards various association operating expenses.

Membership will provide you with periodic editions of **Diablo** in which you may post queries and other 508th related materials. The newsletter, of course, will also provide details of the planned annual meetings and activities as they arise.

So, get out your pens and checkbooks and send in your registration form along with the initiation fee. Please note that until the association incorp-oration process is completed, checks must be made out in the name of Richard O'Donnell.

All these materials must be converted to digital format through the use of a document scanner.

If you do not have the means to scan your photos and documents, please consider mailing them to the site's Webmaster (AKA "Jumpmaster"). We provide free scanning services and typically are able to mail the materials back within 48 hours of receipt.

Many veterans and family members have already shared their materials and in some cases have entrusted us with entire photo albums. All have been returned undamaged to their owners. (Note: scanning of albums necessarily takes longer). Return mailing is done at our own expense.
