The site of the 508 PIR 27th Annual Reunion is located five minutes from **Tampa International Airport**.

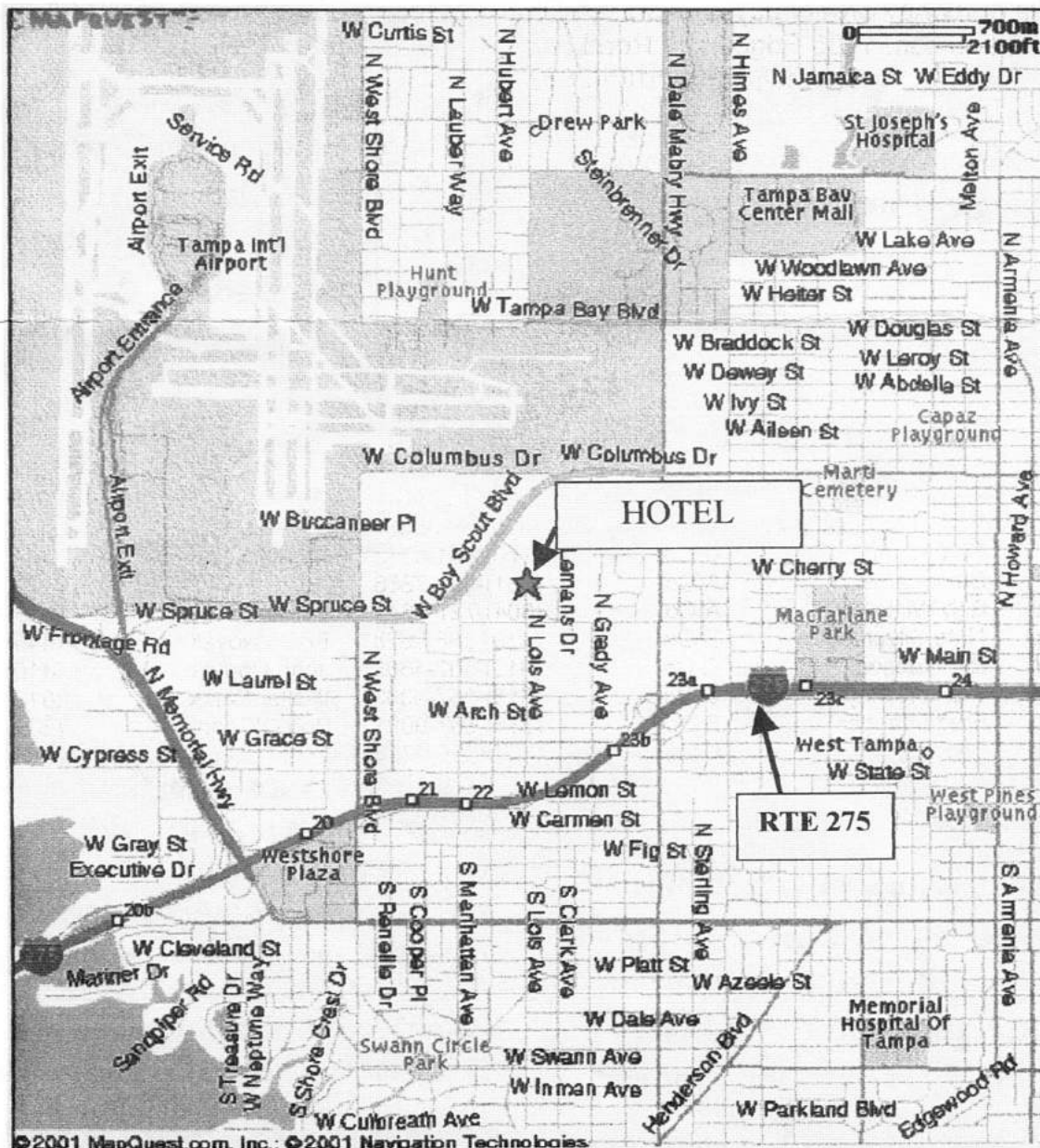

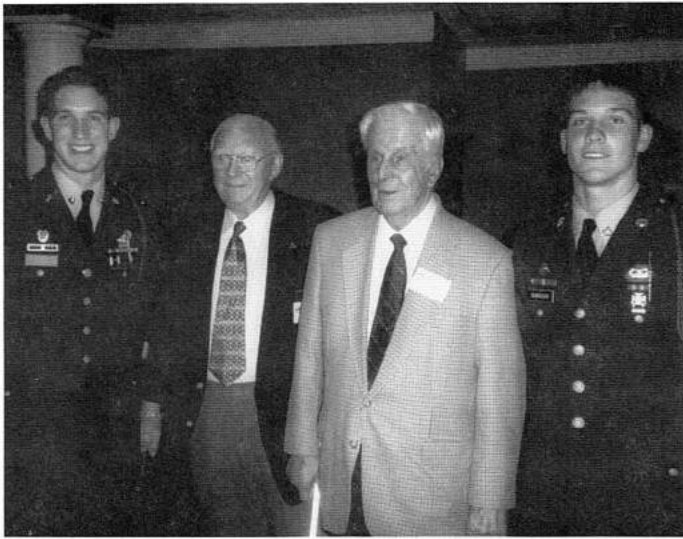
**Barbara Asher** has arranged with the Hotel to sponsor a **COMPLIMENTARY Continental BREAKFAST** for all the ladies in attendance.

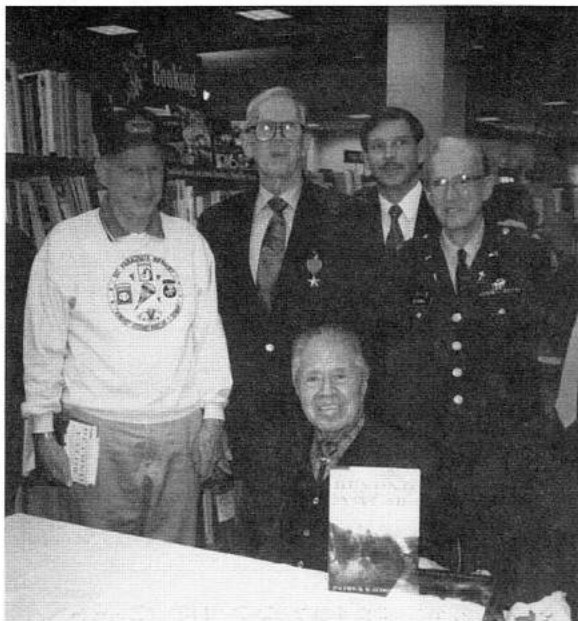


**The Legend Continues in the Airborne & Special Operations Museum in the heart of downtown Fayetteville, North Carolina.**

The spectacular architecture occupies a beautifully landscaped six-acre site. The center lobby is five stories high. Admission is FREE. A tour through the exhibits recreates sights and sounds of war-torn villages of Normandy. Bus loads of school children, Boy Scouts and teen-agers make educational tours of the Museum daily. Active duty troopers from Fort Bragg dressed as combat troopers of WW II circulate as guides talking to veterans of Normandy and Holland **This is a WORLD CLASS Museum – don't miss it!**



The 508 Memorial in the Garden, one of many at the rear of the Museum, is an inspiring tribute to Paaratroopers everywhere.



**General Louis G. Mendez at Book-signing March 31, 2001. The book, "BEYOND VALOR", by Historian, Patrick K. O'Donnell was praised by General Hugh Shelton.. Three men of the 508 are represented in the book, Mendez, Lamoureux and John Hardie. Lou Mendez, Hq Co, 3<sup>rd</sup> Bn relates his encounter with death in the fighting on July 4, 1944 at la Haye- du- Puits. The Bronze Star Medal was presented by Colonel Mendez to Francis M. Lamoureux, G Co, Pathfinder nearly 57 years after jumping into Normandy with the 3<sup>rd</sup> Bn Pathfinder Team. Lamoureux's account of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Bn attack on Pretot on June 20, 1944 is in the book. John Hardie recounts action in Holland with "C" company on September 18, 1944. With 1<sup>st</sup> Sgt. Leonard Funk fearlessly leading the way they cleared the drop zone held by German troops to provide a secure landing for glider troops coming in with supplies. The book-signing took place at Barnes & Noble, Springfield, Virginia. George Stoeckert, Hq 1<sup>st</sup> was on hand to assist Lou Mendez.**
