FINAL PAYMENTS AND DATES

This is the latest from O.B. Just a few days ago. The final arrangements eliminated May 10 as a refund date. The cost remains at \$800.00 per person round trip. Deposits will be accepted until April 1. The final payment is due April 15. Cancellations will be accepted until April 15 with no charge. Any cancellations after April 15 will cost \$50.00 per person.

You have until April 15 now to make up your mind, and have all your money paid. These are governmental rules applying to bargain flights and cannot be changed so get busy.

PASSPORTS

You get them at your County Clerks office. Bring a certified copy of your birth and a drivers license. You must know your fathers and mothers place of birth and the date. You will need a \$10.00 check or money order and \$3.00 cash for clerks fees. You will also need 2 copies of a special passport photo 2 inches by 2 inches. Ask your photographer, he knows the requirements.

The passport will take 4-5 weeks to be delivered once all of the above is complete. There is an extra charge for special, speedy delivery.

June 2, 1978

6:00 P.M. depart from JFK Airport in New York for Paris, France.

6:00 A.M. Arrive at Paris. Depart on chartered bus for Normandy immediately after claiming luggage.

June 4,

Dedication of 508 Park in Chef du Pont. Evening banquet being planned and arranged.

June 5,

Visit Ste. Laurent cemetery, tour of the general area, search for your DZ, find your fox hole, etc.

June 6, 34th Anniversary of D-Day...... Official ceremonies held in Ste. Mere Eglise. Reception and banquet will follow. Visit the Airborne museum.

June 7,

Depart 9:00 A.M. for Paris. Check in at hotel and then attend a reception at the American Legion in the evening.

June 8,

Free day and night for shopping, sightseeing, etc.

June 9, Depart 9:00 A.M. for Belgium, (Bulge Area), Arrive in P.M. Check in at hotels. - Receptions in hotels.

June 10,

Visit Henri Chappelle Cemetery, Bastogne, Malmedy, Vielsalm, Ste. Vith, Haute Bodeux Deidenberg, etc. General tour of the area. Free evening.

June 11.

Depart 9:00 A.M. for Holland. Arrive Berg en Dahl. Visit Margratten Cemetery on the way. Afternoon reception in hotel. Free evening.

June 12,

Visit DZ, Wyler, Germany, Nijmegen Bridge, Groesbeck, Arnhem, and general area of prior battles. Evening reception.

June 13,

Depart 9:00 A.M. for England. Ferry boat across the channel. Busses will meet us in England to take us to Nottingham. Free evening.

June 14,

Full day to tour the area, visit Wollaton Park, Beeston, The Horse & Groom, Ye Olde Trip to Jerusaleum Inn. Etc. Evening reception.

June 15, Depart 9:00 A.M. for London. Afternoon & evening free to tour London on your own.

June 16.
Free day for touring and sightseeing.
P.M. departure for New York City, JFK Airport.

June 17, Early A.M. arrival at JFK. Completion of trip.
