FIRST SITTING	DINNER	1700 Hour
SECOND SITTING	DINNER	1745 Hour

The first sitting will have moved out of the room by 0805 and 1735 in order that the second sitting can be served. Smoking will be allowed, provided it does not cause lingering and delay in clearing the room by the time specified.

Meals aboard this transport are not chargeable to officers. Tips to waiters are not required but at the end of the voyage it is customary to give tips to the waiters at your tables.

Before officers will be admitted to the dining room, beginning Breakfast, 29 Dec. 43, they must have table assignment cards. These cards can be obtained from Transportation Office on Prom. Forward Deck (deck above state rooms).
