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#### GLOSSARY

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**FAIS DO-DO** (Literally "go to sleep") A Country dance, in Cajun country including the entire family from grandpere to the tiniest baby. "Do-do" derives from the childish expression, a variation of "*dormir*" (to sleep).

**VOODOO** (Dahomey, *vodu*, a deity) An African cult, once an animistic religion subject to many variations, good and bad, imported to New Orleans by African slaves.

**GRIS-GRIS** (Gree-gree, African variation of French meaning gray-gray) Amulet, talisman or charm, worn for luck or used to conjure evil on enemies of Voodoo devotees.

**PRALINE** (From Marechal duPlessis Praslin, whose cook invented it) A sweet bon-bon made of pecans browned in sugar. Pronounced: Praw-leen.

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
